BOIL WATER ADVISORY FOR SOUTH RIVER NOW LIFTED

Dr. Jim Chirico, Medical Officer of Health, is pleased to announce the lifting of the boil water advisory placed on the South River water supply on Saturday July 17, 2010. The lifting is effective immediately. Dr. Chirico states that he is now confident that conditions have returned to consistent acceptable levels.

The turbidity is within acceptable limits. The test results show that there was no contamination of the water supply and the disinfection process is working.

Residential users of the community's water supply are advised to run each of their cold water taps for one minute on first-time use. Large-volume users are advised to run cold water taps for two minutes on first-time use.
